- I. *Luke 14:7-11-* Think lowly of service and position, not highly like every denomination or cult does
- II. Psa 40:1-7- Old Testament had a deeper hidden meaning
 - A) Heb 10:1-7- Shadow of things to come
 - B) Heb 3:1-6- Moses House a type of Christ's House
 - C) *1 Cor 10:1-*6- Israel an example for the church
 - D) *Gal 4:19-31-* Allegorical meaning behind Old Testament stories

III. Patterns of 7

- A) 7 days of creation
- B) 1st 7 books of bible
- C) 7 dispensations or ages
- D) 7 feasts of Israel
- E) 7 parables of *Mt 13*
- F) 7 churches of Asia
 - 1. Notice how the number 7 is often broken down into 4 + 3
 - i. Spring, Summer, Fall, Winter + Spring, Summer, Fall (Harvest)
- IV. Churches in Rev 2 & 3 were real assemblies in John's day
 - A) Each assembly had the problems written about or else the statements are untrue
 - 1. Yet there can be another application or applications, to each individual at various times, to each assembly at various times, to the various assemblies in a city, and ultimately to the church throughout the dispensation (microcosm)
 - B) Israel's history has been repeated by the church, only worse
- V. The 7 churches as examples of the church throughout the age
 - A) **Ephesus** *Rev* 2:1-7 ("desirable, precious, beloved")
 - 1. 30-70ad- Church joined unto Christ, yet departs "first love"
 - i. Ex 19:4-6- Israel joined unto the Lord and departed the Lord
 - *a*) Hos 11:1
 - b) Jer 2:2
 - ii. Parable of Sower planting seed (beginning)
 - B) **Smyrna** *Rev 2:8-11* ("bitterness")
 - 1. 70-312ad- Church persecuted outwardly and corrupt seed planted inwardly
 - i. *Num* 14:33- Israel persuaded into unbelief by certain men among them *a) Heb* 3:7-4:2
 - ii. Parable of the Tares sown among the wheat (division/corruption)
 - C) **Pergamos** *Rev* 2:12-17 ("twice married, tower")

- 1. 312-500ad- Church joined to Roman state by Constantine and combined with Paganism
 - i. Num 25:1-3-Israel joined unto Baal-Peor through Balaam's counsel
 - a) Num 31:16
 - b) Jude 2-13
 - ii. Parable of Mustard Seed growing into a huge tree and the fowls lodging in it
- D) **Thyatira** *Rev* 2:18-29 (continual sacrifice")
 - 1. 500-1500ad- Church becomes Holy Roman Empire with doctrine completely corrupted
 - i. *1 Kings 16:28-34-* Israel officially joins the nation unto idolatry by the entry of Jezebel and her false prophets
 - a) Ezek ch 16
 - ii. Parable of the Leaven hidden by the Woman and the whole leavened
- E) **Sardis** *Rev* 3:1-6 ("remnant, those escaping")
 - 1. 1500-1700ad- Men begin to revolt against Holy Roman Empire and Protestant Reformation begins, yet they don't fully break from Rome's doctrine and begin to imitate Rome again after time
 - i. *2 Kings 14-17-* Judah goes to war against Israel but still doesn't fully end corruption and idolatry, and ultimately are cast out of the land also
 - a) 2 Chr 26- Uzziah revolts against idolatry
 - b) 2 Chr 27- Jotham does right, but the people return to idolatry
 - c) *2 Chr 28:24* Corrupt King Ahaz shuts doors to temple and makes an alliance with Assyria
 - d) 2 Kings 19:30- Yet a remnant are there and shall be planted
 - ii. Parable of the Treasure hid in the field
- F) **Philadelphia** *Rev 3:7-13*("brotherly love")
 - 1. 1700-1900ad- Remnant escape the continent and bring the Word of God westward
 - i. *Ezra & Neh* Remnant of Judah depart Babylon and return to the land to build the House of God, sacrifices begin again, people dedicate themselves to the Lord again
 - ii. Parable of the Pearl
- G) **Laodicea** *Rev 3:14-22* ("people justice, or the people judging")
 - 1. 1900-present- Church becomes consumed by "love of money" and gathers in any who will join and contribute \$\$\$
 - i. *Mal ch 1-4-* Levite priesthood completely corrupted by covetous
 - ii. *John 2:13-17-* Judah turns House of God into a "den of thieves", even adding a court of the women, and a court of the Gentiles to increase \$\$\$
 - 2. Parable of the Net cast into the water and gathering of all kinds
