- E) Phil 1:9- Paul prays the abound in knowledge and discernment of the more excellent things

- G) Eph 5:18-20- Paul prayed to give thanks for all things and to keep his mind stayed on the Lord
- H) Eph 6:18- Paul prayed and then watched the Lord work
- I) Phil 1:19- Paul prayed because he believed in the outcome
- J) Col 1:12-14- Paul prayed because he was thankful for salvation
- K) Col 4:2- Paul prayed to watch the Lord perform and returned thanks
- L) Col 4:12- Paul prayed because it was a labour we are privileged with
- M)1 Thess 3:10= Paul prayed in order that he might be able to edify them
- N) 1 Thess 5:18- Paul prayed because it is the will of God
- O) 2 Thess 3:1-2- Paul prayed in order that the gospel have free course
- P) 1 Tim 2:1-6- Paul prayed because God will have all men to be saved and therefore Jesus Christ died for all men
- Q) Phile 7 & 22- Paul prayed because he believed it's outcome on the brethren and on himself
